Please make sure that your child has enough lunch food to fill them up. Afternoon snack will be served at 2:00pm.



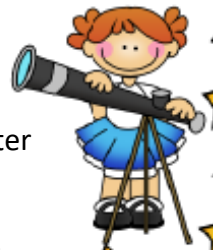
What We're Learning
