<p><b>Space Camp</b>          (Ms. Robin and Ms. Karen)</p>	<p><b>June 3-7</b>          8:30-12:30</p>	<p>Prepare to blast-off for a fun-filled week of Space Camp! Activities include: place setting, making center-pieces, serving guests, hand washing, table manners, silverware usage, clean-up, and dish washing.
